WHAT IS ISLAMIC ARTS SOCIETY?

It is a group of people who want to share the beauty of Islamic arts. The society organizes various art events, including calligraphy demonstrations, art classes, and the annual Islamic Arts Festival.

WHAT IS ISLAMIC ARTS FESTIVAL?

It is a festival to celebrate the beauty of Islamic arts. It is the largest festival of Islamic Arts in America.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT AT THE ISLAMIC ARTS FESTIVAL?

You can expect to enjoy the rich tradition of Arts in Islam. You will see Islamic arts, including calligraphy, woodwork, glasswork, ceramic tiles, and paintings from local artists. You can buy art too. In addition to the visual arts display and sales, there will also be a Film Festival, Nasheed, spoken art program, Muslim comedy show, and Sufi music entertainment program.

WHAT TYPE OF EVENT IS ISLAMIC ARTS FESTIVAL?

It is a fun and interactive indoor art festival for people of all ages. During the festival, demonstrations of Calligraphy, Henna (the art of temporary tattooing based on mignonette tree dyes), Ebru (aqueous surface design), and other art forms are held in the Houston Hall. Performance programs are held in the Theater.

WHO MAY ATTEND?

Everyone. This event is open to the general public. People of all faiths and backgrounds are welcome.

WHEN IS THE FESTIVAL?

The festival is held in fall every year. It is a 2-day weekend event.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The event is free. There is no fee for the visual arts display program. The other programs may have a fee; check the main festival page.
